- We have achieved a major milestone recently. SAA has been approved for a Permanent (or Absolute) Charter by NY's Dept. of Education and the Board of Regents. ⁽²⁾
- Our wonderful teachers have done a phenomenal job teaching the last three years despite COVID.

Inflation is having a significant impact on our budget projections for next year.
